
Who Translated The Ekklesia Bible?

In the English, The Ekklesia Bible is translated similar in part like all other English Bible translation. The First English Bible translation is made by John Wycliffe first in the English Bible translation by a member of the Catholic church. The Wycliffe Bible translation that was made first for members of the Catholic church.

All English translated Bibles have their roots in the first English translated Bible called the Wycliffe Bible. The Wycliffe Bible today sets the standard in doctrine in most all the more popular Bible translations made first for Catholics by leaders of the Catholic church. Fed into the belly of her religion or is fed to the] full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns. [Amplifying in brackets is mine.]

Take note, The Wycliffe Bible a false Bible translation is a Bible translation that is fed to the full of names of blasphemy. The Wycliffe Bible is a Bible translation made only from the Catholic Catechism and the Latin Vulgate and the Wycliffe Bible made for members of the Catholic church is not a Bible translation from any ancient Bible manuscript.

How do we know the first Catholic translation of the Wycliffe Bible to this day sets the standard for Doctrine for all the most popular Bible translations? All the most popular bible translations have the same words and names of blasphemy that was

mistranslated first into the Wycliffe Bible translation.
